PEDIATRIC SURGERY ALMC.

The pediatric surgery unit is within the surgical Department, although it's independent. Surgeries done in the unit are; - Anorectal malformation care starts from day of birth(colostomy, PSARP, Colostomy closure), depending on the severity of the patient. Tracheal esophageal fistula repair, Gastrostomy feeding tube, Anterior abdominal wall defects care (Gastroschisis, Omphalocele), Hirschprungs disease reconstruction(Preliminary colostomy Abdominal perineal pullthrough), Interstinal atresia repair (type I to type IV), gastrojejunostomy with brown procedure. Neonatal obstructive jaundice(biliary atresia, choledochal cyst type I – IV), Kasai procedure, Ramstedit procedure for hypertrophied pyloric stenosis, Nephrectomy, Neuroblastoma surgical excision post Neo-Adjuvant chemotherapy, Mainz –pouch II, Ureteric reimplantation, urinary bladder augmentation, umbilical hernia and Ventral hernia repair with /without mesh, Inguinal Hernia repair, orchidopexy/orchidectomy, Ambigious genitalia reconstruction, Hypospadias repair, urethral plasty.
